## Camp Directors

Head Coach Don Maines is his 4th season as Head Baseball Coach at Long Island University. This will be Coach Maines 18th season coaching college baseball at the division I level. Coach Maines is already Drexel University Baseball's all time wins leader with 258 coaching victories in 13 years. The effects of Maine's coaching influence began to surface immediately as the Dragons improved from four victories in 1991 to 19 wins the following spring. Under Coach Maines direction, the Drexel Baseball team appeared in the America East Championship game three times in 1993, 1995, and 1996. Maines assumed control of a Drexel program that had enjoyed just two winning seasons since turning Division 1 in 1990. Four years later, in 1994, the Dragons posted their first of four consecutive winning campaigns with a 26-17 overall record. Don is married with 2 boys and he resides in Newtown, Pa.

Council Rock High School North Head Baseball Coach Matt Schram finished his 5th season as Head Coach at New Hope Solebury High School. Coach Schram compiled a 5 year record of 76—31. His teams have won 3 district championships, and one league championship. Coach Schram has been selected as Coach of the Year in 2006, 2008 and in 2009. Coach Schram is entering his 12th year of coaching High School Baseball & his 11th year working with Coach Maines at the Touch Em' All Baseball Camps. Coach Schram has previously coached at Great Valley High School, Plymouth Whitmarsh High School, Council Rock High School South, and recently at New Hope-Solebury High School.
